THE TOWNSHIP OF MUSKOKA LAKES AT A GLANCE...

LARGE GEOGRAPHICAL LAND AREA:

Situated on the southern tip of the Canadian Shield, The Township of Muskoka Lakes boasts a geographic land area of approx. 774 sq. km featuring 80 pristine lakes, scenic rock and hiking trails, and a natural wildlife habitat for all of Muskoka residents and visitors to enjoy!


POPULATION:

Permanent Population: 7,652

Estimated Seasonal Population: 26,992

Population Density per sq. km: 9.9 Average Age of the Population: 50.6

We're growing! In 2021, the enumerated population of the Township of Muskoka Lakes, was 7,652, which represents a change of 16.2% from 2016. This compares to the provincial average of 5.8% and the national average of 5.2%.
